SOP Roller, Pedestrian Operated

GENERAL & START UP

Read and understand manufacturer's operational manual
Complete pre-operational checklist (never use faulty or defective machinery)
All operators must be free from the direct and after effects of drugs and alcohol
Never operate in a poorly ventilated area, carbon monoxide is colourless, odourless and poisonous
Ensure work area is clear of bystanders and hazards prior to starting engine and operating machine
Once engine is started confirm control pattern and machine function
Ensure remote control unit is fully charged prior to operating this roller (if applicable)

TRAVEL & OPERATION

- ! **NEVER** USE PHONE WHILE OPERATING MACHINE
- ! **NEVER** EXCEED MANUFACTURERS MAXIMUM GRADE STATEMENT
- ! **ALWAYS** KEEP FEET CLEAR OF ROLLER

Ensure throttle control is at idle position prior to starting machine
Always hold roller control handles firmly with both hands
Stay alert and look for holes and other hidden hazards
Never pull running roller towards yourself
Watch out for traffic when operating near roads, driveways and parking areas
Stop engine and wait for the roller to stop prior to moving the roller to a new work area
Operate only in full light conditions
Keep engine free of grass, leaves and excessive grease. These can be a fire hazard

- ! **NEVER** LEAVE RUNNING ROLLER UNATTENDED
- ! **ALWAYS** KEEP VISIBLE CONTACT WITH REMOTE CONTROLLED ROLLER (if applicable)

When stopping the roller: Park on even ground. Shift the gear selector to park position and apply the parking brake. Turn off the ignition and remove the keys

VIBRATION RISKS

Prolonged exposure to vibration can cause permanent damage to the fingers, hands and arms of operators
The following precautions MUST be taken:

- Wear gloves and keep hands warm and dry
- Hold tools firmly, but do not grip too tightly
- Take regular breaks
- If tingling or numbness in hands or arms occurs stop work immediately and report incident

TRANSPORT & MAINTENANCE

- ! **ALWAYS** switch off and isolate machine, engage articulation locking device prior to performing any maintenance or transportation
- ! **ALWAYS** stop the engine before checking, cleaning or maintaining the roller
- ! **ALWAYS** use approved lifting and restraining points when lifting and restraining on trucks or trailers
- ! **NEVER** drive steel wheeled machines on any steel surfaces

REFUELLING

- NEVER** refuel unless the engine is stopped and ignition turned off
- NEVER** smoke during refueling
